

CU Boulder = \$7.2 million

#### CU Boulder - Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2023 preliminary enrollment is currently projected to be 1.8% over fall 2022, and 1.3% over the June budget
- Preliminary first-year cohort is projected to be 7,375 students, an increase of 3.8% over fall 2022, and 3.1% over the June budget
- Transfer students are projected to be at 1,501 students, an increase of 79 students (5.6%) over fall 2022
- Continuing undergraduate students are projected to be at 21,370 students, an increase of 315 students (1.5%) over fall 2022
- Incoming undergraduate student increase from June is nearly all resident students and mostly explained by students enrolling at a higher than anticipated rate
- Fall 2023 graduate enrollment was originally projected to be down over fall 2022 (-2.5%), but is now projected to be inline with fall 2022
- Additional revenue from enrollment will run through the campus budget model



#### UCCS - Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2023 preliminary enrollment as of 8/21 is currently projected to be 0.1% above fall 2022 and over the June budget by 0.3%
  - Total student credit hours are up 1.3% from June budget estimates
- Compared to fall 2022:
  - New undergraduate first year student increase of 93, or 5.6%
  - Graduate student enrollment increase, both resident and non-resident, with non-resident graduate student increase of 78, or 33.5%
  - Total non-resident population continues to increase with a growth rate of 9.0%
  - Non-resident international graduate student increase of 33, or 41.8%

#### CU Denver – Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2023 preliminary enrollment is -3.7% below fall 2022, and under the June budget by -0.9%
- Preliminary fall 2023 enrollment indicates a smaller incoming freshman class than budgeted
- Graduate enrollment has decreased in both new and continuing students
  - Decrease in international graduate enrollment, impacted by campus' shift to requiring external credential evaluations in response to industry-wide increased scrutiny of foreign credentials. This change resulted in fewer completed applications.
  - Continuing international graduate enrollment is slightly above projections, but total is off-set by decreases in continuing resident and non-resident graduate students
  - Some decrease in new international graduate enrollment was predictable due to record fall 2022 enrollment (notable increase above five-year average)

#### CU Denver FY 2023-24 Balancing Efforts

- Continue planned budget realignment process for FY 2023-24
- Honor commitment for approved 3.0% merit pool increase for campus employees
- Continue campus-wide focus on enrollment:
  - Enact diligent recruitment efforts for spring intake to complement fall enrollment performance
  - Focus on marketing of and recruiting for high-growth programs delivered in online and hybrid modalities
  - Enhance cross-campus collaborations to increase yield of new students and persistence of continuing students
- Reduce planned budget increases and expenses:
  - Target specific positions to fill, based on student impact and employee workload needs
  - Reduce planned 2% compression/retention/equity funds, hold on distributing any that may be available until Comprehensive Compensation Collaborative framework is complete
  - Utilize retirement incentive funds on a one-time basis



#### CU Denver Next Steps

- Fall 2023 Develop additional plans to align revenues and expenses for FY 2024-25
- January 2024 Regent Finance Committee internal campus budget model
- February 2024 Revised current year base budget as starting point for FY 2024-25 budget development

 Fall 2023 preliminary enrollment is currently projected to be 1.5% above fall 2022 census and slightly below June budget

#### Higher enrollment in School of Medicine MD Program

- 38 student increase in fall 2023 preliminary estimate from fall 2022 census
- \$708,000 increase to budget

Lower enrollment in School of Pharmacy across PharmD, Master of Pharmacy and PhD

- 35 student decrease in fall 2023 preliminary estimate from fall 2022 census
- -\$523,000 decrease to budget
