Directions for each:

• Reciprocal Parking Permit holders:

Follow the Driving Directions below and meet with the parking attendant (marked with a star on the map). The attendant will verify your pass, will give you a special tag to display with your reciprocal pass, and direct you to parking location.

Self-Pay Parkers:

Follow the Driving Directions below and meet with the parking attendant (marked with a star on the map). You will work with the attendant to manage payment to park for the day and he will direct you on where to park. Parking is \$10. Credit cards are preferred but cash will be accepted.

Driving Directions to the Center for Community and Parking Lots 308 (Reciprocal/Paid)

- Take I-25 North to Hwy. 36 (a left exit)
- Take Baseline Road Exit
- Turn Left onto Baseline Road
- Turn Right onto Broadway Street
- Turn Right onto Regent Drive
- Turn Right onto Kittredge Loop Rd
- Look for and meet with the parking attendant (see the star on the attached map)
