- From the South:
 - Take 1-25 North to Colfax Avenue
 - Take Colfax east to Lincoln
 - Turn left (north) on Lincoln
 - Turn right (east) on 19th Avenue to Grant Street
 - Turn right (south) on Grant to 1800 Grant

- From the North:
 - Take 1-25 South to Park Avenue
 - Take Park Avenue east to Broadway
