Approval of minutes

LGBTQ Symposium

The committee agreed on the following regarding the symposium:

- Angela Sauaia, M.D., associate professor of Public Health, Medicine and Surgery, University of Colorado, and author of "The Quest for Health Equity." will deliver the keynote address. The committee will develop key points that the keynote should address.
- Dr. Brenda Allen, Associate Vice Chancellor for Diversity and Inclusion will give the opening remarks.
- Regent Ludwig has confirmed his attendance. Lindsay O'Connell will discuss the symposium with him and update the committee.
- The agenda will also include a student panel. Committee members will provide a list of potential student panelists at the September meeting.
