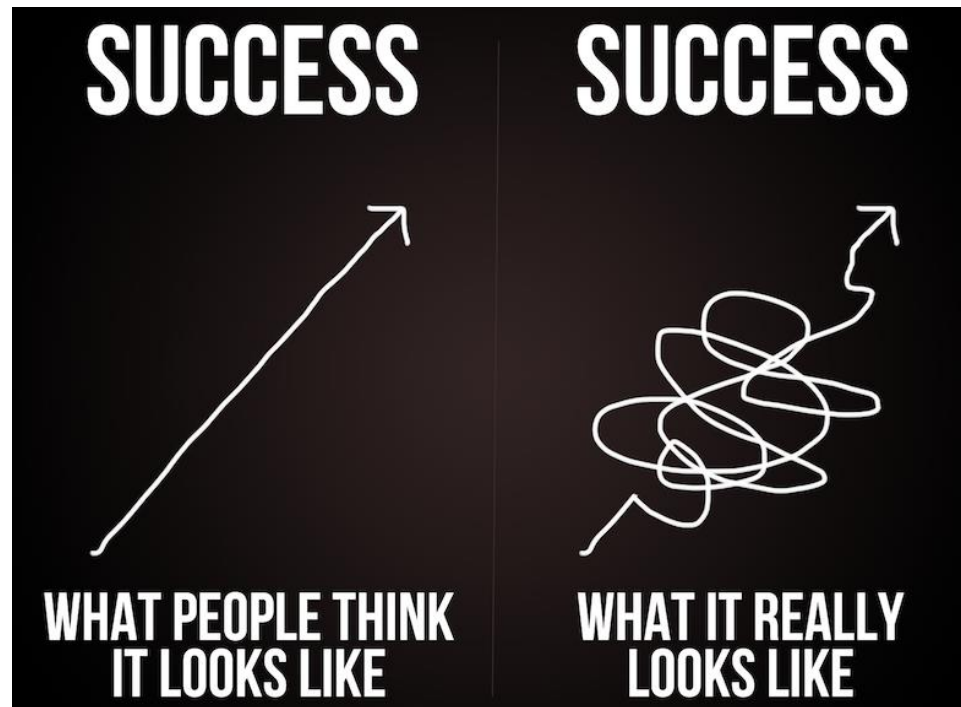

4 Biggest Time Wasters

1. Commuting
2. Meetings
3. Emails
4. Technology



Commuting

- Video conferencing – use technology to your advantage
- Shift work schedule
- Virtual meetings – use technology when appropriate; determine if face to face is necessary, if not use technology
- Use public transportation to allow time for planning your day, checking emails, etc.

Meetings

- Set agenda – lead to action items; shorter meetings
- Strong leader
- Start on time, end on time; Have an agenda and follow it; determine who is necessary
- Ensure appropriate people and amount of time

Emails

- More short talk, less email
- Be mindful to check/follow-up in a timely manner; at least 2-3 times a day
- Bullet point emails; be specific in needs; be more patient with sender; sorting/organizing tools to manage emails; be respectful (i.e. replying to all)
- Picking up phone; face to face; IMing

Technology

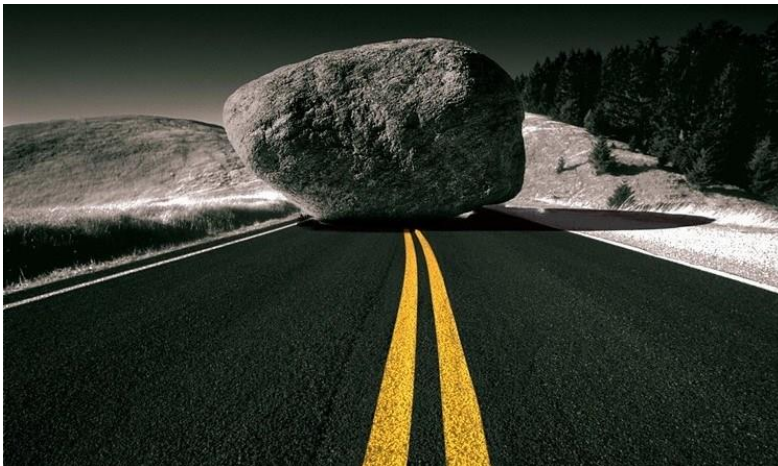
- More/better resources to support: communication, structured release schedules, clarity between technology and user language
- Technology breaking – ensure development and testing is fully completed at the expense of a timeline; quality vs. quantity
- Ignore social media
- Restrict access to social media

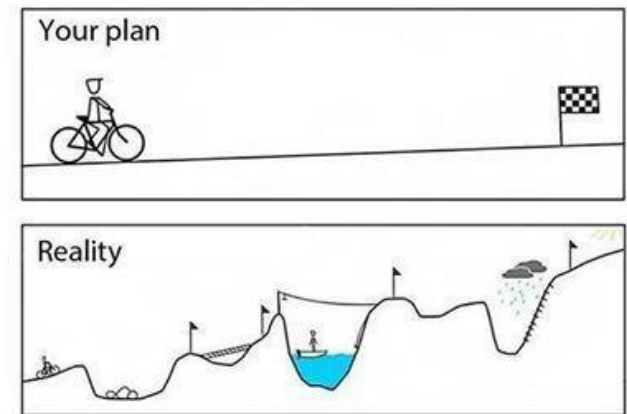
