New resources coming to CU Employees

The University of Colorado's Employee Services department is expanding to include Financial Education. The new unit won't officially launch until fall 2014, but it has already begun to roll out programming and resources.

Employees and retirees looking to take an informed, proactive approach to their personal finances will be served by this new offering.

Topics will include all aspects of personal finance, from everyday budgeting or making big purchases, to navigating financial transitions and planning for major life events.



The Financial Education unit will be led by Katie Sauer, a CU-Boulder alumna. Sauer holds a doctorate in economics and has spent the past decade teaching undergraduate economics and graduate-level personal financial literacy professional development courses for K-12 teachers.
