- In any kind of report, we could share our process of outreach to indicate we made an "honest effort" to penetrate campus faculty channels
- Concerns about "email overload"
- More of a table of contents, a roadmap for navigating resources
- The research process for this guide shows the need for a guide like this! UCCS has more of these resources easily available, other campuses do not.
- The larger the school, the more complex, the more resources, and the harder to find what you need
