





#### Between 1990 and 2022, CU awarded -

  - 63% of degrees are bachelors
  - 56% of degrees by awarded by CU Boulder










## University of Colorado Data Included in Earnings Analysis (Input-to-Results)

- Over 50% of alumni are employed in the Management, Computer, and Business Occupations •







### **College Degree Recipients Average Higher Annual Earnings and Lower Unemployment**


- Earnings increases with degree level










- Alumni Outcomes tool is a publicly available resource that shows average annual earnings for CU graduates based on field of study
