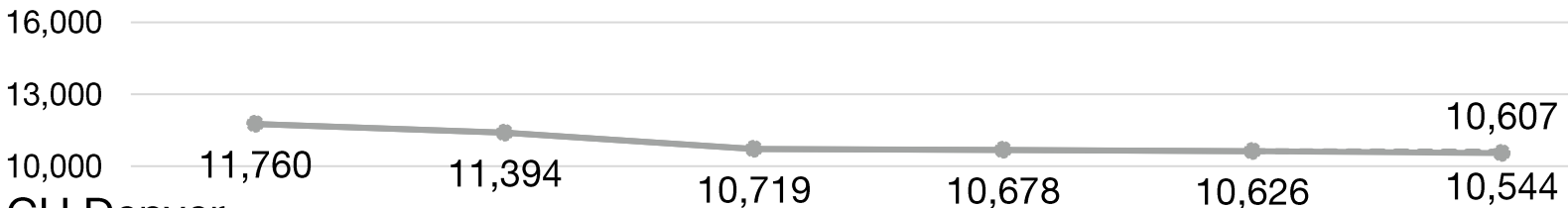

# Projected Revenue from 1% Increase in Undergraduate Enrollment

- CU Boulder = **\$8.5 million**  
\$2.7 million: resident undergraduate  
\$5.8 million: non-resident undergraduate
- CU Denver = **\$0.9 million**  
\$600,000: resident undergraduate  
\$300,000: non-resident undergraduate
- UCCS = **\$0.98 million**  
\$783,000: resident undergraduate  
\$196,000: non-resident undergraduate
- CU Anschutz = **\$113,000**  
\$92,000: resident undergraduate  
\$21,000: non-resident undergraduate

# CU Boulder – Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2025 census enrollment is +1.0% over fall 2024, and -1.6% under the June budget, with growth primarily coming from undergraduate resident students
- First-year cohort is 7,397 students, a decrease of -0.5% from fall 2024, however it's an increase of +2.6% over the forecast in the June budget
- New transfer enrollment is 1,520 students, a decrease of -88 students (-5.5%) over fall 2024
- Continuing undergraduate enrollment is 23,603 students, an increase of +704 students (+3.1%) over fall 2024
- Graduate enrollment is 6,288 students, a decrease of -201 students (-3.2%) from fall 2024, but an increase of 88 students over the June budget
- International student enrollment is decreasing but not as much as forecasted with undergraduate down -13.8% and graduate down -8.0% at fall 2025 census, versus June forecasted declines of -24.3% and 14.7%, respectively
- Changes in revenue from enrollment changes will run through the campus budget model

# UCCS – Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2025 census enrollment is down -0.2% over fall 2024, and +0.6% above the June budget
  - This is an improvement over the June forecast of -0.8% decrease from fall 2024 to fall 2025
- Fall 2024 to Fall 2025 year over year changes:
  - Graduate enrollment increase +6.0%
  - Resident enrollment flat 0.0%
  - Undergraduate enrollment decrease -1.0%
  - Non-resident enrollment -3.0%
- New first-year student enrollment down -13.8% from Fall 2024
- State reportable student credit hours down -1.4% from Fall 2024
- Compared to budget resident enrollment came in higher than June forecast for both undergraduate and graduate students.

# CU Denver – Enrollment Overview

- Fall 2025 census enrollment is +0.9% over fall 2024, and +2.7% over the June budget
  - New First-year undergraduates increased +5.6% compared to prior year, driven by strong growth in Colorado residents
  - New transfer students increased +3.6% over fall 2024 due to strengthened recruitment and yield efforts
- Continuing undergraduate students up +1.0% year over year, better than budgeted due to significant efforts to reenroll eligible students
  - Census data suggest record-matching 1st to 2nd year retention of over 76%, up from 73% in Fall 2024 and 71% in Fall 2023
- New graduate students down -2.4%, with declines in non-residents countered by growth in resident Master's students
- Continuing graduate enrollment decreased slightly, -1.4%

- Fall 2025 census enrollment is +1.9% over fall 2024, and -0.7% under the June budget
- Year-over-year higher enrollments in:
  - College of Nursing, BS Nursing, +34 students (+7.2%)
  - School of Medicine, DPT Hybrid Program, +36 students (+106%)
  - Skaggs School of Pharmacy, PharmD Program, +29 students (+7.8%)
- Year-over-year lower enrollments in:
  - Colorado School of Public Health, Master of Public Health, -36 students (-7.7%)
  - College of Nursing, Doctor of Nursing Practice, -10 students (-8.2%)
