## **Navigating the Building and Finding the Room:**

- Enter the capitol through either the north-side First Floor Entrance or southside Basement Entrance (wheelchair access) and proceed through security screening.
- Meet in the north-side Old Supreme Court, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

- Coffee and beverages are available in the cafeteria, in the basement. Cash is preferred; credit cards require a minimum purchase.
- Food is not allowed in the Old Supreme Court Chambers nor the Galleries.
- Public restrooms are in the basement, through the cafeteria.

## **Driving Directions to the State Capitol Building**

- From the South:
  - Take 1-25 North to Colfax Avenue
  - Take Colfax east to Lincoln
  - The Capitol Building is located between Lincoln and Grant St. and Colfax and 14<sup>th</sup> Ave. (See Parking Information)
- From the North:
  - Take 1-25 South to Park Avenue
  - Take Park Avenue east to Broadway
  - o Take Broadway south to Colfax. Turn Left onto Colfax.
  - The Capitol Building is located between Lincoln and Grant St. and Colfax and 14<sup>th</sup> Ave. (See Parking Information)

#### **Parking Information**

- 1. The Cultural Complex Garage, at 12<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Broadway https://denverparking.spplus.com/65-west-12th-avenue.html
  - You will walk down Broadway to 14<sup>th</sup> Ave. Turn Right onto 14<sup>th</sup>. You will see the Capitol Building on your left and ahead of you. (see map)
