There is free public Wi-Fi available at the capitol. The user name is **COGAwifi** and no password is required. Simply agree to the terms and conditions and click "connect".


Driving Directions to the State Capitol Building

- From the South:
 - Take 1-25 North to Colfax Avenue
 - Take Colfax east to Lincoln
 - The Capitol Building is located between Lincoln and Grant St. and Colfax and 14th Ave. (See Parking Information)
- From the North:
 - Take 1-25 South to Park Avenue
 - Take Park Avenue east to Broadway
 - Take Broadway south to Colfax. Turn Left onto Colfax.
 - The Capitol Building is located between Lincoln and Grant St. and Colfax and 14th Ave. (See Parking Information)


Parking Information







