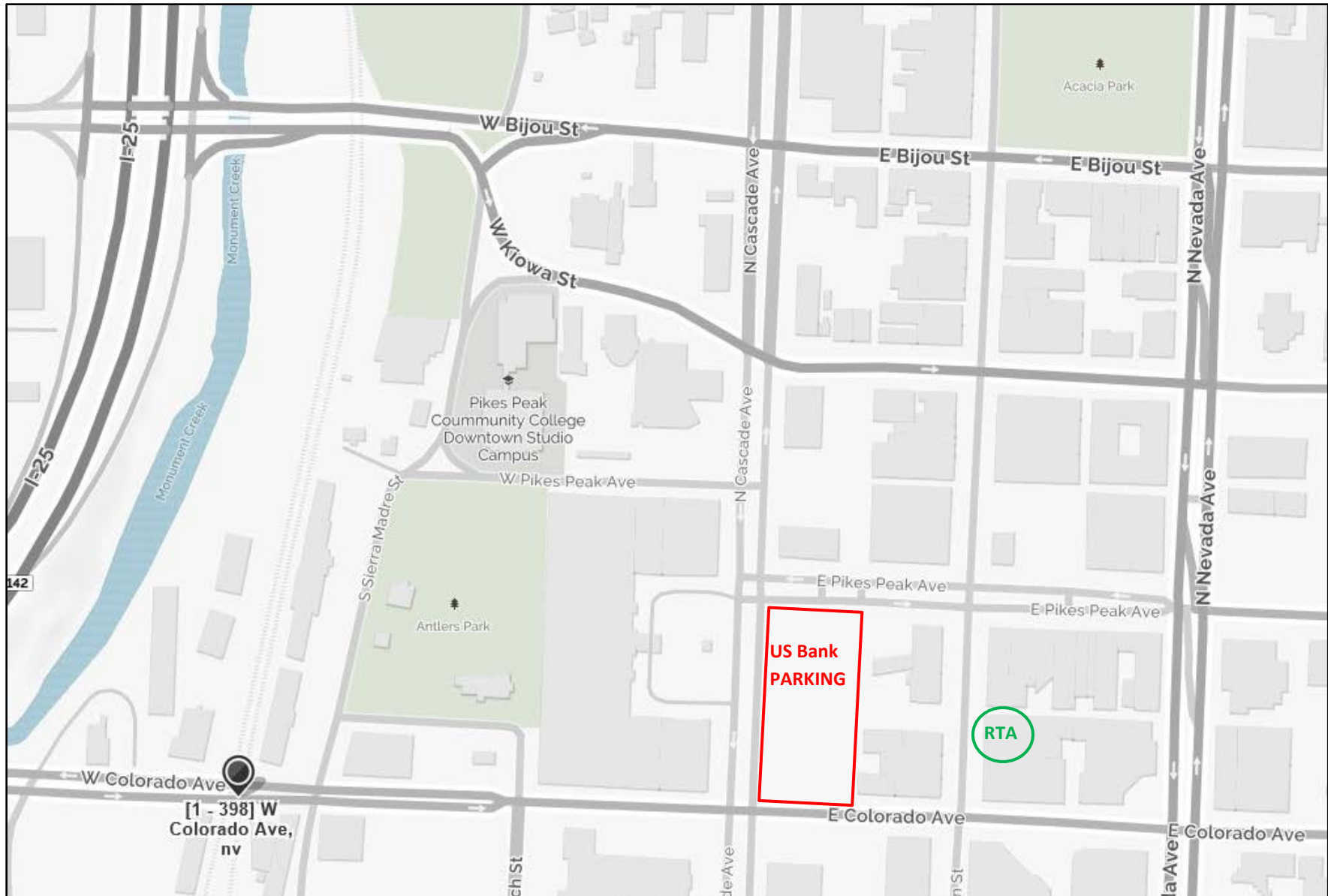

DIRECTIONS TO PARKING AND RTA:

From I-25 South, take Exit 142/West Bijou Street

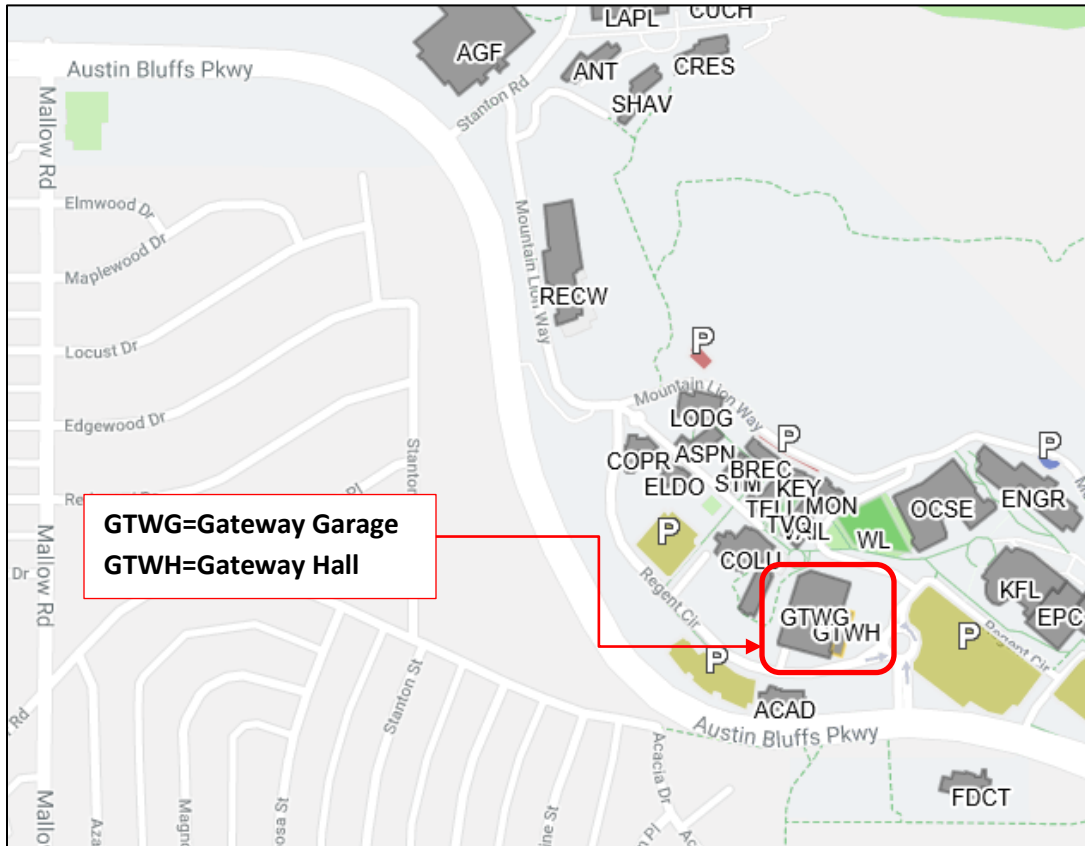
Turn right (heading east) onto West Bijou Street. Eastbound West Bijou Street will veer to the right and will turn into West Kiowa Street. Stay on West Kiowa Street until North Cascade Avenue. At North Cascade Avenue, turn right, drive two blocks until you can turn left onto East Pikes Peak Avenue. As soon as you turn onto East Pikes Peak Avenue, look for an entrance into the parking lot. (Pikes Peak Avenue is split. A left-hand turn onto West Pikes Peak Ave comes up first, followed by a right-hand turn onto East Pikes Peak Avenue.) The parking lot is on North Cascade Avenue between East Pikes Peak Avenue and East Colorado Avenue.

RTA is located across South Tejon Street, approximately in the middle of the block between East Pikes Peak Avenue and East Colorado Avenue. It is near/above the Chipotle Restaurant.

DIRECTIONS TO UCCS CAMPUS FROM RTA:

From the parking lot near the RTA Offices, go east to North Nevada Avenue, approximately one block, and turn left (north). Stay on North Nevada Avenue until you get to Austin Bluffs Parkway, turn right (east).

Stay on Austin Bluffs Parkway and take the first right-hand turn after Stanton Way. This turns into a traffic circle which merges into Regent Circle. Stay in the traffic circle until you can drive west onto Regent Circle. Gateway Hall and Gateway Garage are the first buildings you come to on your right. Turn right into the garage and go to the 3rd floor where visitor parking is allowed.



Gateway Hall is attached to the east side of Gateway Garage.

Gateway Garage (below): The 3rd level is for visitor parking and is the level we should use. All other levels are reserved.



Gateway Hall (below): Enter the building through these doors and go down the main hall. Room 107 will be on the right.
