RE:	Recommended Elimination of Article 8

Recommendation

The recommendation is to eliminate Article 8 from Regent Laws and Policies. There are no regent policies related to this section.

Part A: Calendar – eliminate

Justification:

• 8.A.1 – This law sets a minimum length (16 weeks) for fall and spring semesters. This is not a high level governing principle that is appropriate to regent law. Furthermore, it reflects an outdated mode of thinking that all courses are offered during a traditional fall/spring semester.

Part B: Commencements - eliminate

Justification:

- 8.B.1 The key statement that gives the President final approval of commencement schedules is currently stated in APS 2001 and is appropriate for an APS, not regent law.
- 8.B.2 The statement relating to commencement attire is not a high level governing principle that is appropriate to regent law.
