USING THE PARKING KIOSK IN THE MONTE VISTA AND SNOWMASS SURFACE LOTS:

Please note, these PayStation kiosks will need your vehicle license plate number WHEN you pay for your parking whether by cash/credit/debit.

 After you enter your license plate, you will see two options on the screen:

Hourly and All Day (7+ hours).

- Select the appropriate for the length of time you will be at the DRB meeting. If you select All Day, the machine will skip asking for the number of hours and will then ask if you have a Parking Code.
- Press the corresponding number for 'No' and proceed with payment.
- The machine will print a receipt if you choose to get one.
- You will have the option to get a receipt for your records but YOU DO NOT NEED to go back to your vehicle to put the receipt on your dashboard. Just pay at the kiosk and continue to your destination.
- Parking rates for these lots are \$1/hour with a daily maximum rate of \$8 for the day.

In case our primary lots are full or you inadvertently end up in another lot, the code is valid in all visitor surface lots EXCEPT the Barbara Davis Surface Lot. The code is also NOT valid in the Henderson Garage. We have a different system for the Garage. Should you end up in the Garage, you will need to call Campus Parking Assistance at the number below so they can come let you out.
