


# Boulder Operating Expenses Very Low Compared to Purdue




## Third Lowest Operating Expense per Student




## Purdue's State Funding Far Exceeds Boulder's







## STEM Programs Greater Portion of Purdue's Enrollment




Universities serve different populations, with Purdue enrolling more engineering and business majors.






## Boulder Research Funding 25% Higher






#### Purdue's Volume Produces Revenue






#### 55% of Purdue's Enrollment is Nonresident






# Boulder Emphasis on Diverse United States Students Purdue Emphasis on International Students






## Purdue International Enrollment is Nearly 3x More






## Percent of Pell Students Declining at Purdue






## Graduate Online Enrollment Growing at Purdue
