## **Parking Information:**

- For those who have a reciprocal parking pass, you can park in any 8-hour lot the closest lots to the Research 2 Building are Snowmass and Monte Vista.
- If you do not have a parking pass, you can park in the 4-hour Vail lot right across from the Health Sciences Building (which is next to Research 2). There is a pay station located in the lot.
- You can find an interactive campus map that includes all parking lots HERE.

## **Pay Station Information:**

The visitor parking lots have automated pay stations. The license plate of the vehicle parked will need to be entered at the pay station upon payment. The receipt does not have to be displayed on the dash of the vehicle. The pay stations accept many forms of payment:

- Cash/coin up to a \$5 bill (Change is NOT given at the machine. A refund receipt will be issued and will need to be taken to the parking office in Building 500/Fitzsimons).
- Credit card payments accepted (Visa, MasterCard, Discover)
