Driving Directions to 1380 Lawrence Street (see below for parking directions)

- From Colorado Springs
 - Take 1-25 North
 - Take the Auraria Pkwy exit (Exit 210B)
 - Turn Right onto Speer Blvd.
 - Turn Left on Lawrence Street (or Arapahoe if parking in the DPAC garage)
- From Boulder
 - Take Hwy. 36 to 1-25 South
 - Take the Speer Blvd. exit (Exit 212B)
 - Take Speer Blvd. South
 - Turn Left at Lawrence Street (or Arapahoe if parking in the DPAC garage)
