Discussion Items:

- 1. Approval of May minutes (APPROVED)
- 2. CU Online Finance Committee with Maja Krakowiak
 - a. Maja updated Budget members on <u>CU Online</u> Finance Committee and her role as a member.
 - b. The project has been put on pause for campuses to agree on a financial model, new consultants were hired to develop a new model. Their findings should be ready by mid-September.
 - c. Many people in the CU community have been advocating for transparency and that the report of their findings be public.
 - d. Consultants are open to hearing any ideas faculty have on how to strategically position CU in the online market.
 - e. Main discussion items were program and campus uniqueness, transparency, concerns of a 5th campus model, and quality programming.

- b. Stay up to date with the System budget as a whole.
- c. Continue working on divestment, learn more about context of the treasury and how it falls with divestment.
- d. Stay up to date with CU Online Accelerator Committee and Finance Committee.
- e. Consider collaborating more with EPUS and Personnel committees.

4. Budget Updates with Chad Marturano

- a. Chad briefly updated the committee on enrollment.
 - i. All campuses are tracking their enrollment relative to what they estimated.
 - ii. There will be a full presentation on enrollment impacts at the Board of Regents September meeting.
 - iii. Silver lining is that graduate enrollment is on the rise.
- b. Chad also presented on CARES Act updates.

- c. The Economic Impact Study will be presented at the September 10 Board of Regent meeting.
 - CU System as a whole generated \$14.2 billion during the 2019 fiscal vear.
 - ii. CU is the 3rd largest employer in Colorado, when furloughs and layoffs happen there are ripple effects in the state economy.
