

Human Capital Management: Job Aid

Default Earnings Codes and Their Pay Groups

This document highlights the default regular and overtime earnings codes and their pay groups.

The default pay is for an employee's normal work. Employees should always be paid using these default regular and overtime earnings codes unless the situation or business process requires other earnings codes, such as late student pay, bonus pay, and other unique situations. The HCM system also uses the configured default regular earnings when paying an employee their salary. (Example: The salary pay for a USX employee is assigned as RGS earnings).
