

### How to Connect to CUSYS Guest Wireless


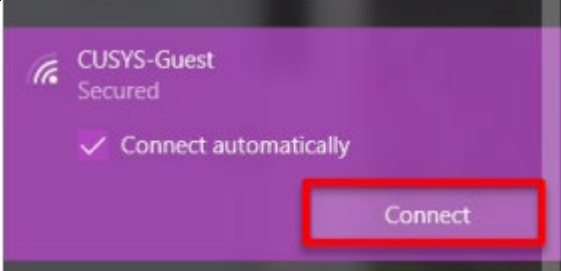
**PURPOSE:**

- How to connect to CUSYS-Guest Wireless on a laptop or [mobile device](#)

CU System's guest network at 1800 Grant requires users to agree to an acceptable use policy (AUP) instead of inputting a password.

An AUP is a digital guardrail. It details the usage guidelines for CU's Wi-Fi network and heightens the protection of sensitive university data. The new AUP brings CU System's guest Wi-Fi access process into alignment with the campuses' processes.

#### How to connect to the CUSYS Guest Wi-Fi on your laptop:

1. Select the <b>Wi-Fi symbol</b> in the bottom right of your desktop.

2. Select <b>CUSYS-GUEST</b> and click Connect.

3. You will be automatically redirected to the AUP page or prompted to open the page in your browser.
4. Click <b>Accept</b> at the bottom of the page.
5. Another page will open, confirming that you are connected to the network. After 5 seconds, this page will refresh and redirect you to cu.edu. You are now fully connected.



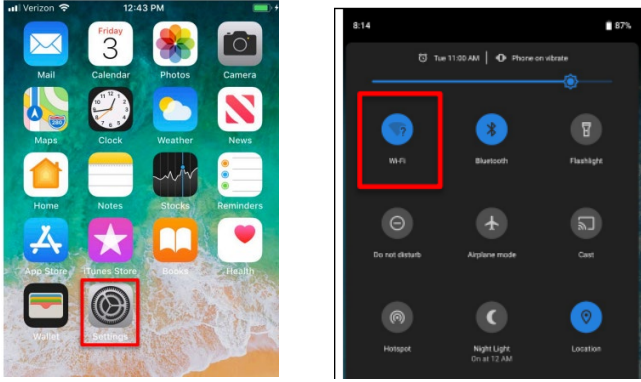

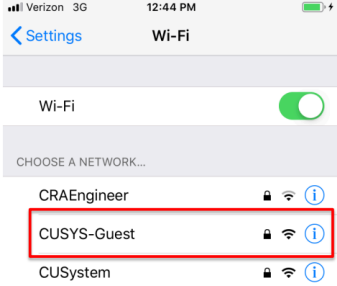

## WIRELESS & NETWORK

**Note:** Depending on your operating system, your browser may automatically open the AUP after connecting to the network, or you may have to open a browser manually. Usually, your device will prompt you to open the page when in the **Manage Wi-Fi Connections** panel.

### Mobile Devices

If you are connecting a mobile device to the network, you may be prompted to “sign into network.” This is the same as opening a browser and accepting the AUP on a laptop or PC.

<p>On an iPhone, click your <b>Settings</b> icon.</p> <p>On an Android device, open <b>Settings</b> and click on <b>Network &amp; Internet</b>, then choose <b>Wi-Fi</b>. Alternatively, you can swipe down from the top to show the <b>Quick Settings Menu</b> and click on the <b>Wi-Fi icon</b> as shown.</p>	
<p>In the Settings menu, click on <b>Wi-Fi</b>.</p>	
<p>In the menu, choose <b>CUSYS-Guest</b>.</p>

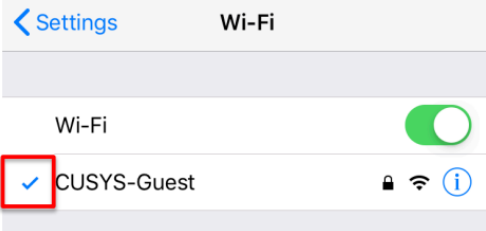
