

HOW TO CONNECT TO EDUROAM WIRELESS:


From the home screen, begin by swiping down from the top to show the Quick Settings Menu.

Long press on the **Wi-Fi icon** in the top left to show the Wi-Fi settings menu and available Wi-Fi networks.

Alternatively, open Settings from the App Drawer, click on Network & Internet and then choose Wi-Fi.



Select **eduroam** from the menu to open the settings.



To connect, enter the following information:



- Under CA Certificate, select “Use System Certificates” or “Do not Validate” from the dropdown.
- In the Identity and or username fields, enter your CU username (lastnamefirstname) appended with the @cu.edu realm; username@cu.edu. Please Note: in this case, @cu.edu does not represent your email address but rather the institution that you are using for authentication.
- In the Password field, enter your CU system password.

Once the information above matches the example, **click Connect** and the screen should change to show the network connecting.

It may cycle through saving, obtaining IP address, and connecting before resting on connected. This is normal. The phone should also show a full Wi-Fi icon in the upper notification bar.

You know you have connected your device to the eduroam Wi-Fi when you see the words “Connected” under eduroam.
