PURPOSE: A guide to restoring deleted files and folders in OneDrive.

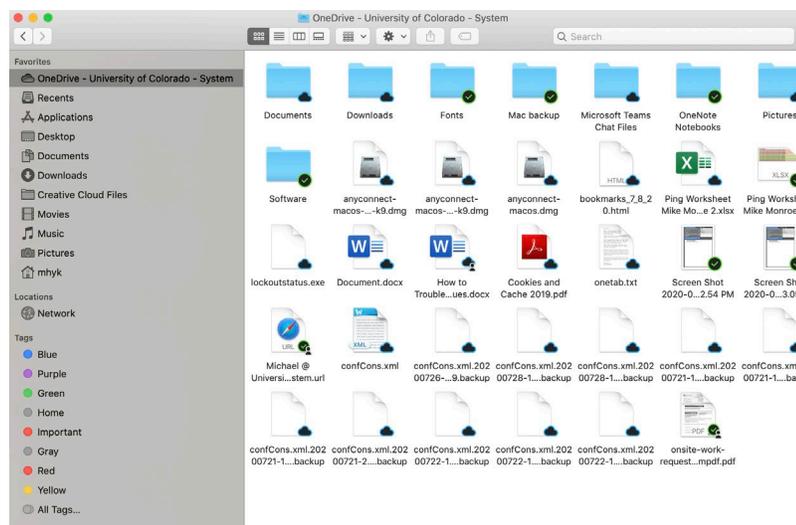
List of items they will learn:

In macOS, the OneDrive folder acts as a local folder that is being regularly uploaded to the cloud.

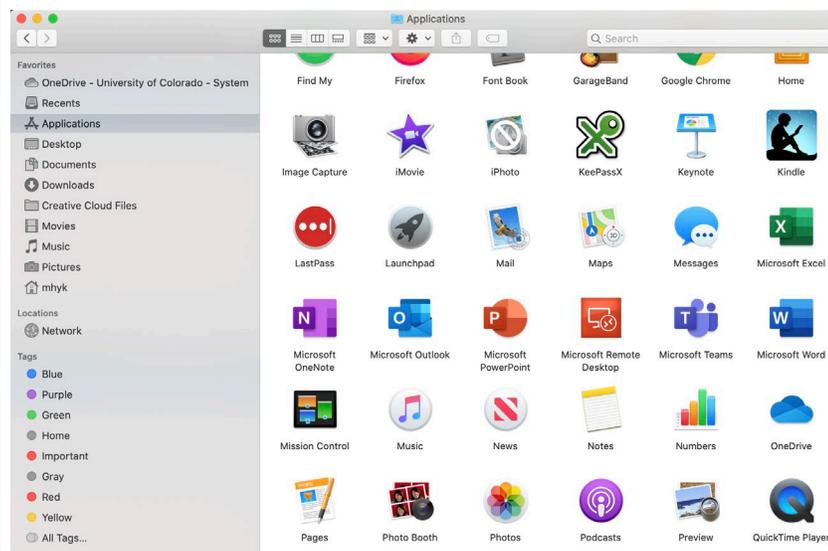
Files placed in this folder will be copied to your account's online storage. This way they're accessible anywhere you can access OneDrive.



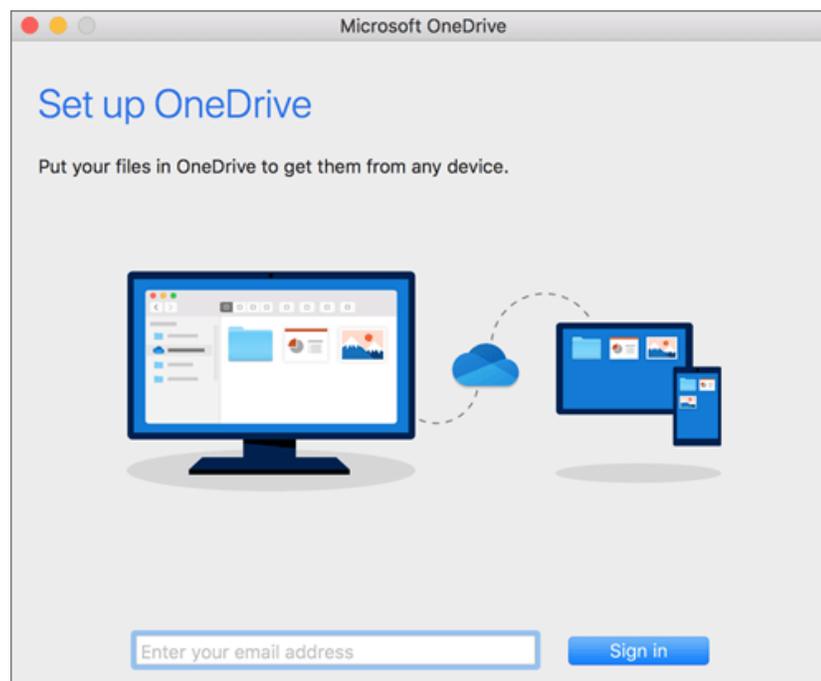

Open OneDrive by clicking on its icon in the Applications folder or from your dock.



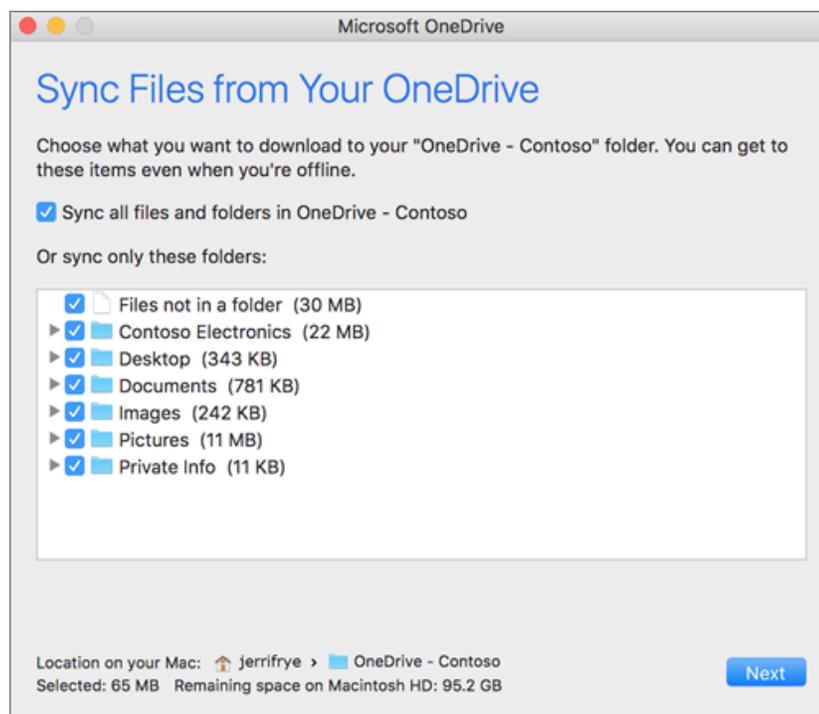
If you have not yet done so, sign in using your username@cu.edu, and your regular password.

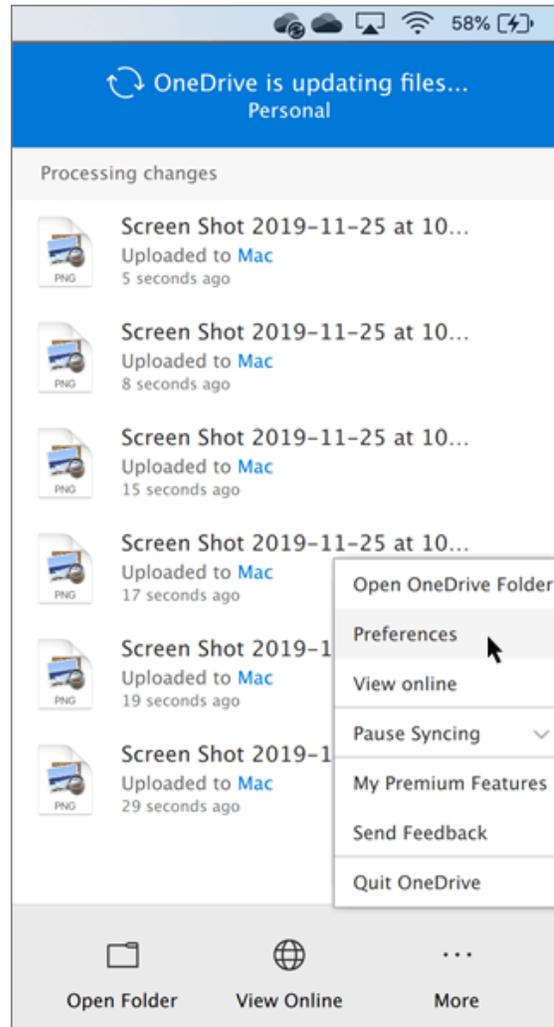

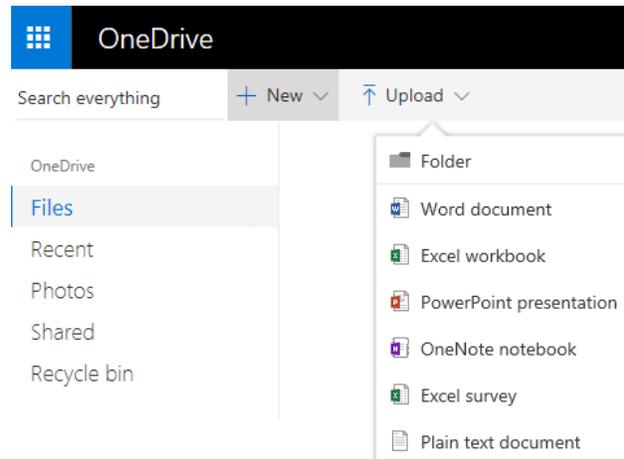
