How to map a network drive



1. Open the Start menu and select Computer.





2. In the Computer window, click on Map Network Drive in the tool bar.





4. Configure the drive mapping

- a. Choose a drive letter (already mapped drive letters will be unavailable).
- Enter the path to the file share (for example, <u>\\ad.cu.edu\Data\yourdata</u>)
- c. If you want this mapping to persist across logins, then check the Reconnect at logon box.
- d. If you have permissions to the share as a different user, then click "Connect using different credentials."
- e. Click Finish.
