














CU Boulder FY 2016 State Appropriations and FY 2017 Tuition & Fees per In-state Student FTE Compared to Peers






UCCS FY 2016 State Appropriations and FY 2017 Tuition & Fees per Student FTE Compared to Peers



■FY16 State & Local Appropriations per FTE












Total Aid for Students with Documented Need






