## 2. REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY

## Policy 2.I: Institutional NeutralityPolitical and Social Expression by Regents

4 5 The Board of Regents recognizes the individual right of its members to express opinions on 6 matters of social and political concern. In accordance with Article 2.A of the Laws of the 7 Regents, unless the Board of Regents specifically determines otherwise, an individual regent's 8 expression of opinion on matters of social or political concern does not constitute an expression 9 by the Board of Regents. In discharging their duties or otherwise exercising official authority 10 granted to the Board of Regents, regents remain obligated to uphold their fiduciary duties to the 11 university. 12 13 The Board of Regents adopts the principle of "institutional neutrality" in social and political 14 matters, unless it determines that the issue directly affects the university, is detrimental to the 15 achievement of the university's mission and purposes, and/or threatens academic freedom. 16

Therefore, the Board may approve exceptions to this principle, based on compelling evidence
that a position or action is in the best interest of the university.
