Regent Policy 7.B: Standards of Conduct

In May 2024, the Regent Governance Committee approved a five-year schedule for the continuing formal review of all regent laws and policies. As part of this process, **Regent Policy 7.B: Standards of Conduct** is currently under review. An initial round of stakeholder feedback on this regent policy was accepted through December 10, 2024. All comments were reviewed and considered, and no additional edits were incorporated in the proposed Draft 0.

Regent Policy 7.B will be on the agenda for first discussion at the Regents Governance Committee on March 25, 2025. No formal action will occur at that time. Stakeholders may send additional feedback until the close of business on April 24, 2025. Policy 7.B was last reviewed and affirmed by the regents in September 2018. Proposed updates include:

- Minor edits are proposed in section 7.B.1(A) to ensure consistent language with Regent Policy 7.D.2 (i.e., reference should be to student government "organization" instead of "group").
- Proposed new language in section 7.B.1(A)(i) references other parts of regent law and policy that are focused on standards of conduct.
