

Skillsoft: Step-by-Step Guide

Creating a Deep Link to Skillsoft

Deep linking allows Skillsoft resources to be accessed directly from a website or pdf. This allows for a better user experience. When a deep link to a course is clicked, the user is directed to log on to the employee portal and then Skillsoft launches the course. This eliminates many of the tedious steps previously needed to navigate to a specific resource within the Skillsoft catalog.

Note:


- University Information Systems (UIS), for security purposes, has asked that you refrain from inserting deep links into emails.
- Employee Learning and Development (ELD) maintains a catalog, with deep links, at: <https://www.cu.edu/employee-services/eld/catalog>
- Users will need to log on separately to access other resources on Skillsoft.

Deep Link a Course

1. Log on to your campus portal (my.cu.edu)
2. Select the **Skillsoft** tile
3. Navigate to the course you want to link
4. Click the course title
5. Click the **About** tab
6. Note the **Library ID** number
7. Use the following template for linking:

8. Insert the complete **Library ID** at the end of the template URL. Example: https://universityofcolorado.skillport.com/skillportfe/custom/login/saml/login.action?courseaction=launch&assetid=_scorm12_cu_u00063_0001 links to the CU Information Security and Privacy Awareness course.

Note: Library IDs will vary by course and resource type. The process of creating a deep link will not change.

Deep Link a Video or Book:

1. Note the **Library ID** number
2. Start with the template URL:
<https://universityofcolorado.skillport.com/skillportfe/custom/login/saml/login.action?courseaction=launch&assetid=>
3. Add “_ss_book:” or “_ss_video:” to the end of the template URL.
4. Add the **Library ID** to the very end of the URL.
