Staff Excellence Award: Rubric

Staff Excellence is described as the quality of being outstanding or going beyond an individual's job duties.

This may include:

- Taking on projects outside the scope of job duties.
- Participation in University activities such as Staff Council, Leadership groups, Committees, Pilot Programs, etc.
- Generating new and innovative ideas in the workplace.
- Participation in outside activities that benefit the job or the University such as professional organizations, Charity organizations, etc.
