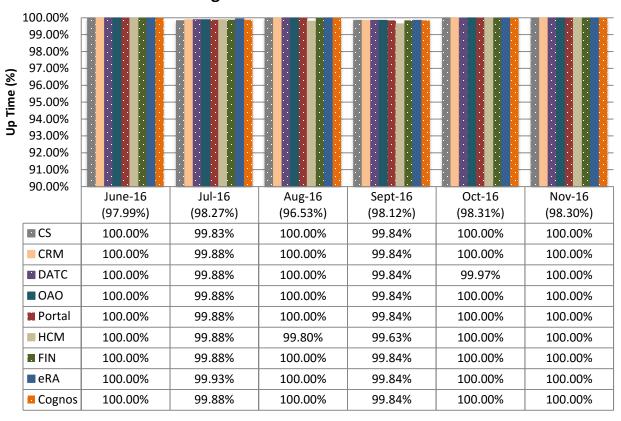

Assuming 24x7 including Holidays Excluding Planned Maintenance Windows



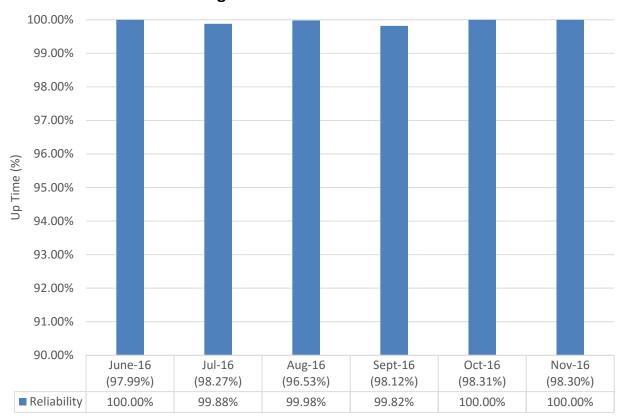
