SALESFORCE SEND EMAILS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reuse a previous send to reduce the need to configure all send components at every send (<i>efficient and less risk for error</i>)</li> <li>• Name the Email Send as desired (<i>valuable for reporting &amp; troubleshooting</i>)</li> <li>• Stay organized by placing email sends in folders</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Less modern interface</li> </ul>
GUIDED SEND	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Send via an intuitive, step-by-step wizard which is easily navigated to while creating an email</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must configure send components for every send (<i>inefficient &amp; increased room for error</i>)</li> <li>• Randomly named email send (<i>difficult to troubleshoot and creates reporting limitation</i>)</li> </ul>
