CU Federal Updates and Actions Page

As a reminder, CU Federal Relations has created a <u>Federal Updates and Actions</u> [3] page to provide access to communications and information regarding the ongoing federal transition, recent executive orders, and their ongoing impact on CU.

FY26 Appropriations and Rescissions Update

The House and Senate are currently in recess and are scheduled to return to Washington on September 2. Prior to the recess, legislators in both chambers began work on Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) appropriations bills ahead of the September 30 deadline when current funding expires. The FY26 House and Senate appropriations status table can be found on Congress.gov [5].

The Senate passed the FY26 Agriculture-FDA, Legislative Branch, and Military Construction-VA appropriations bills [6] on August 1. The Senate Appropriations Committee approved the FY26 Defense [7] and Labor, HHS and Education [8] appropriations bills on July 31.

The House passed the FY26 <u>Defense</u> [9]appropriations bill on July 18. The House Appropriation Committee approved the FY26 <u>Energy-Water</u> [10] and <u>Transportation-HUD</u> [11] bills on July 17, the <u>Interior-Environment</u> [12] bill on July 22, and the <u>State-Foreign Operations</u> [13] bill on July 23.

President Trump signed the Rescissions Act of 2025 (<u>H.R. 4</u> [14]) into law on July 24. \$9 billion in funding for public media and foreign aid that had previously been appropriated by Congress was rolled back in the package. Read more about the package at <u>CPR News</u> [15].

VA Secretary Visits the Marcus Institute for Brain Health at CU Anschutz

U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Secretary Douglas Collins visited the Marcus Institute for Brain Health [16] (MIBH) at CU Anschutz Medical Campus on July 22. Secretary Collins toured the physical performance laboratory and creative arts therapy program and participated in a roundtable discussing the role of the MIBH in treating traumatic brain injuries (TBIs). Secretary Collins was joined by Colorado Governor Jared Polis, Chancellor Don

Interest accrual restarted for borrowers enrolled in the Saving on a Valuable Education (SAVE) Plan on August 1.
