The goal was to highlight the recent national security initiatives undertaken by our campuses, including the effort by CU Boulder's leadership to launch the National Security Is Initiative Is as well as President Kennedy's new National Security Advisory Group Is that brings together leaders from all four campuses to ensure coordination and collaboration on Department of Defense (DoD) related efforts on a quarterly basis. President Kennedy met with key stakeholders at DoD as well as members of Colorado's congressional delegation on Capitol Hill. Meetings at the DoD included Dr. Mark Lewis, Director of Defense Research and Engineering for Modernization and Dr. Derek Tournear, Director of the Space Development Agency, and Brigadier General Rodney Lewis, Deputy Director for Operations, Operations Team One, National Joint Operations and Intelligence Center based at the Pentagon.
