The “Connect to Thrive” event was a follow up to a 2011 conference, which resulted in the “[Better Serving Those Who Have Served](#)” ^[3] report. The 2015 conference focused on topics such as rural veterans and access to health care, behavioral health, community networking and collaboration, and veterans in transition.
