Employee Services recently released three new queries to help with a variety of tasks, including identifying employees who need E-Verification, getting details on earnings codes and looking up campus department location codes.

### **CUES\_HCM\_EVERIFY\_PROJ – E-Verify Needed**

This query returns a list of active employees who have not been E-Verified but are receiving pay from a project speedtype that requires this verification.

### **CUES\_HCM\_EARN\_CODES – Earnings codes**

This query returns a list of active earnings codes with descriptions and details.

### **CUES\_HCM\_LOCATION\_CODES – Location codes**
