

System fixes refine transaction page functionality ^[1]

You may now enter multiple transactions with the same effective date thanks to a fix rolled out Tuesday night.

This is especially helpful when entering transactions that change job and position data, such as terminating and rehiring and employee on the same day.

HCM now pulling correct row for terminations

Two weeks ago, we reported that the [group termination transaction page](#) incorrectly pulled ^[3] the second-to-last row of an employee record instead of the most recent row. This was also resolved during Tuesday's migration, and group terminations should now work as expected.
