

Change Portrait PDF Into Landscape ^[1]

Most m-Fin reports render PDF in landscape orientation. A few do not, however, such as m-Fin OUTSTANDING ENCUMBRANCES. You can override this.

Rather than clicking on the report name itself, use its *Run with options* button.



Ignore everything here and proceed directly into the advanced options.
