“Drills” are what we call the numbers in the reports that you can click on to run another report.

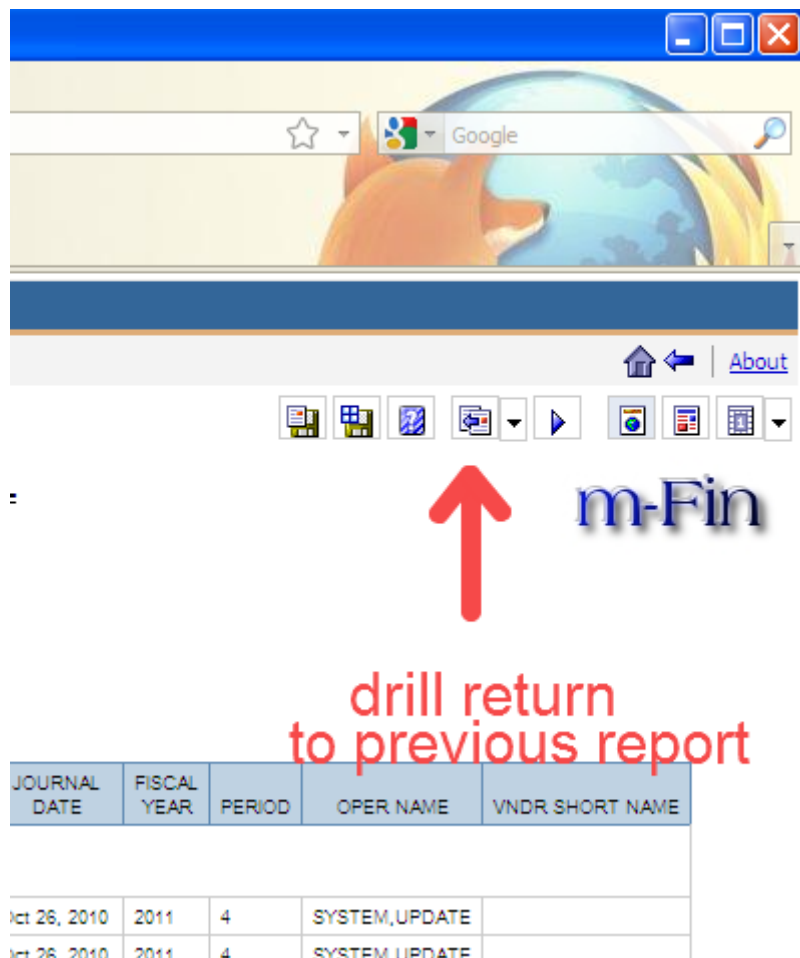
