

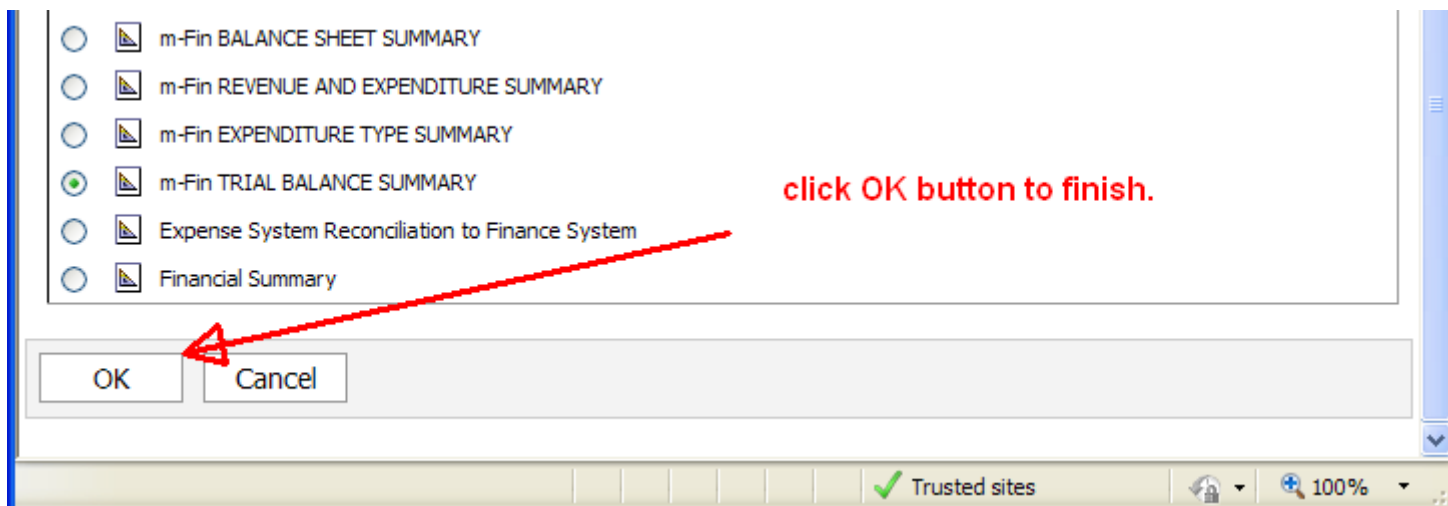
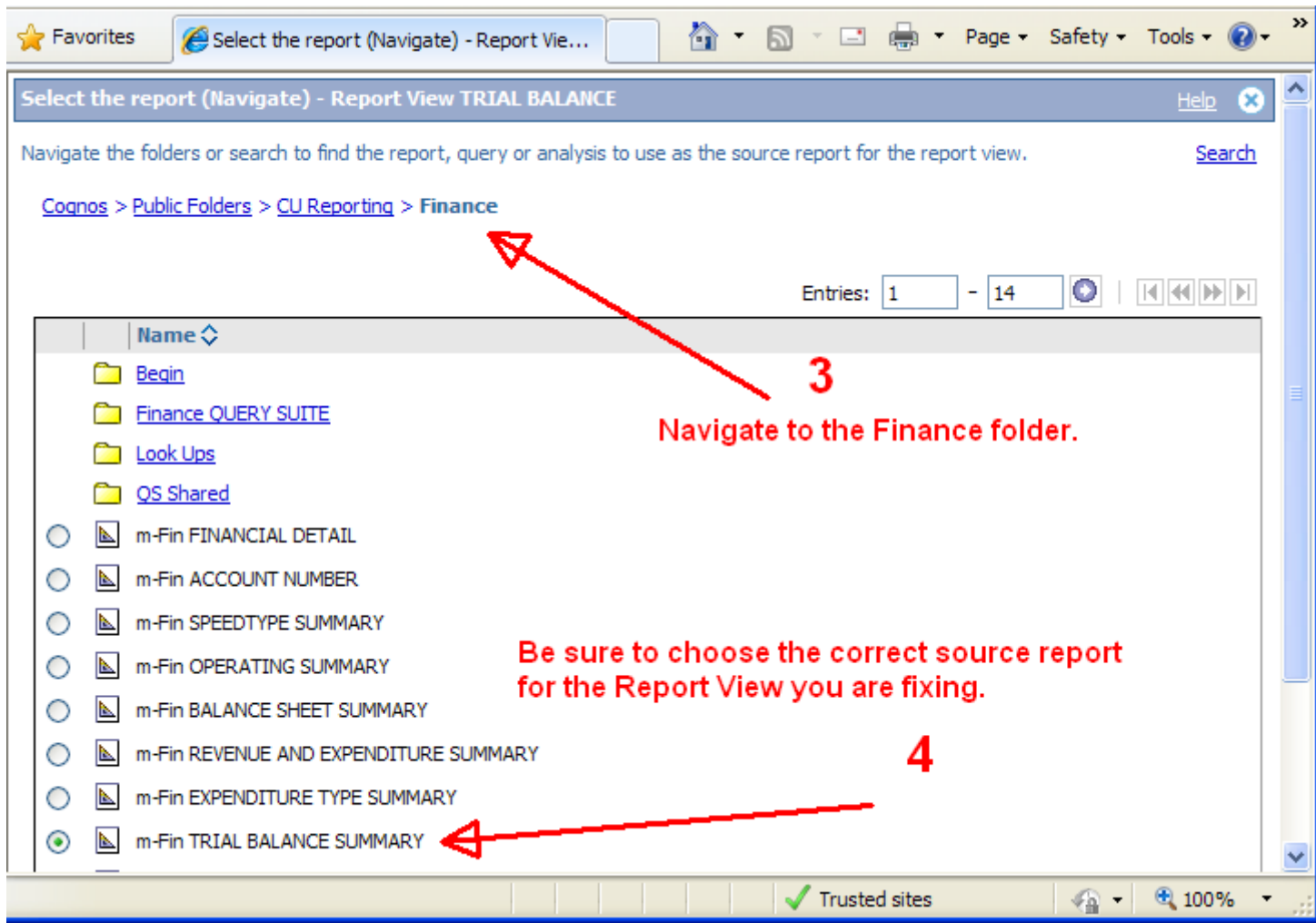
## Repair Broken Report Views <sup>[1]</sup>
