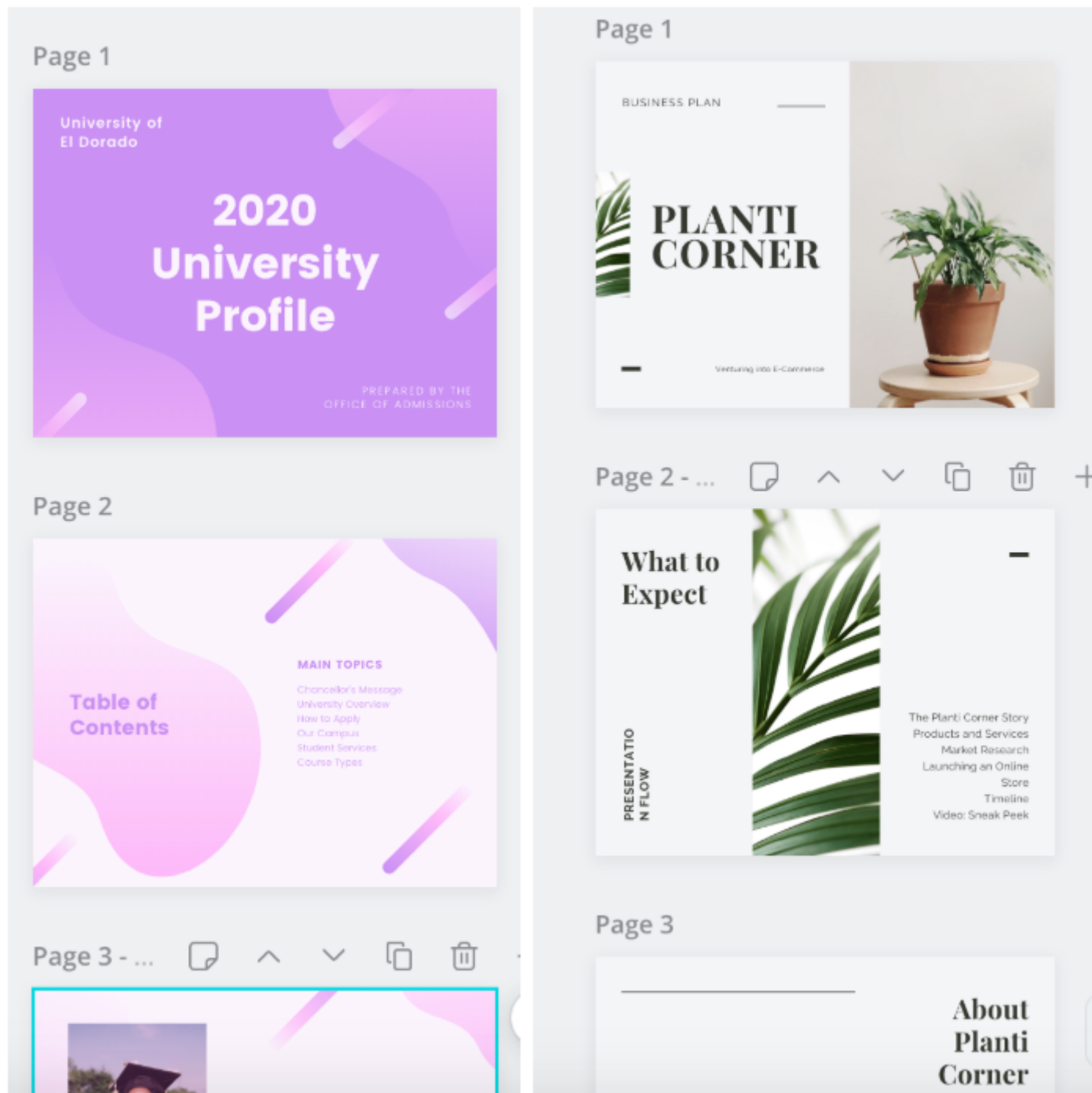

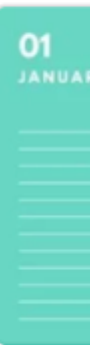
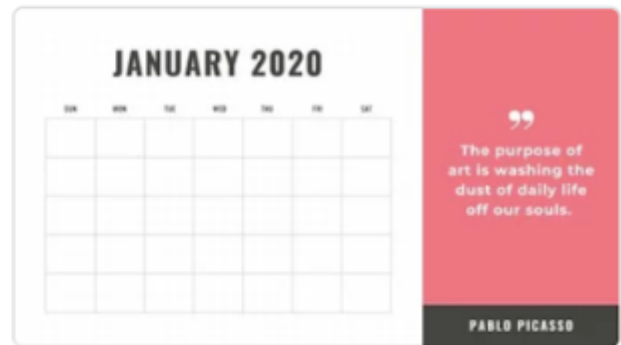


3. Staying Organized

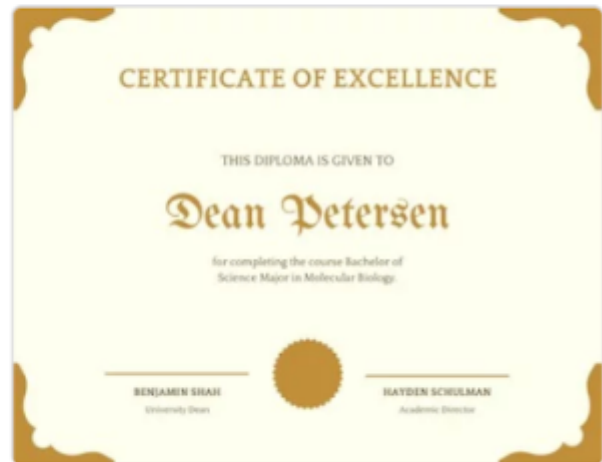
