- New regulatory language form the Veteran's Administration (VA) has come out regrading licensure disclosures and institutions requirements for compliance (thanks for the heads up Jodi!!).
 - <u>R.7105</u> Johnny Isakson and David P. Roe, M.D. Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020? [3]
 - Became Public Law No: 116-315 on January 5, 2021.??Effective 6/15/21 and applies to all educational institutions as of?8/1/21
 - Specifically related to us and our work is this a requirement that, as part of our notifications, we will need to provide to the students -?
 - any conditions or additional requirements, including training, experience, or examinations, required to obtain the license,? certification, or approval for which the course of education is designed to provide preparation; ?

MHEC (WICHE's sister organization) is hosting a webinar on Isakson & Roe is (thankfully) allowing us in this region to attend. ?The webinar is on June 24th at 12pm MDT (1pm CDT).?
