- Click drillable links for the Indirect Expense fields, making it easier to validate facilities and administrative fees and investigate any exceptions.
- View any expenses posted before the project start date or after the project end date.
  Clicking on these amounts reveals detailed transaction information, including dates, descriptions and any associated invoices.
- Maintain a list of common sensitive account codes for the GM Financial Report Tool to look for and call out during processing.

These enhancements, while subtle, significantly improve the usability and depth of information available to users of the GM Financial Report Tool. Grant accountants and project administrators have shared their enthusiasm for the tool in surveys, saying:
