

Internet Explorer upgrading to Version 11 on all System Administration Windows computers ^[1]

On January 12, 2016, Microsoft stopped providing support for Internet Explorer versions below Version 11. To ensure System Administration stays up-to-date with Internet security and compatibility standards, UIS will push Internet Explorer 11 to all Windows PCs as part of the Tuesday, March 15 Windows update package. Older versions of Internet Explorer will be upgraded during this time and we do not expect any impact to your settings or Favorites list. Please note that Macs are unaffected by this update.

UIS is in the process of updating [Supported Browsers](#) ^[3] to ensure you have current information to determine the best browser for the application in which you are working. The recommended browser for each application is indicated on this page.
