

Save money on summer tuition: Submit your Tuition Assistance Benefit application ^[1]

Are you or your dependent taking classes this summer? Save money on your bill by submitting the [Tuition Assistance Benefit](#) ^[3] application through the [employee portal](#) ^[4].

Benefit details

The [Tuition Assistance Benefit](#) ^[3] provides eligible employees and their dependents with tuition waiver assistance for up to 9 credit hours per academic year.

There are two options for dependents: They can attend a CU employee's home campus and receive 9 waived credit hours or attend a different CU campus and receive a tuition waiver of \$270 per credit hour, up to 9 hours. (Dependents of CU Boulder employees receive a 30 percent tuition discount when attending CU Boulder.)

NOTE: An employee must waive their benefit for the academic year if they want their verified dependent to use it. The Tuition Assistance Benefit applies **only to the cost of credit hours**. Employees and dependents are responsible for all non-waived tuition, campus student fees and taxes.

Follow these steps to begin using the benefit

Step 1: Apply to your campus as a student before the semester begins

- CU Boulder
 - Maymester deadline: April 30, 2018
 - Sessions A, C and D deadline: May 21, 2018
 - Julymester, Session B deadline: June 26, 2018
 - Augmester deadline: July 23, 2018

- CU Anschutz - [Contact your school or college](#) ^[6]
- CU Colorado Springs - May 1, 2018

Step 2: Submit the tuition waiver benefit application (Late applications will not be accepted.)

- CU Boulder - August 10, 2018

- CU Denver | Anschutz
 - Maymester: May 14, 2018
 - Summer semester: June 12, 2018
- CU Colorado Springs - June 18, 2018

Step 3: Register for your courses

Dependents - On their registration day

Employees – First day of session

- CU Boulder sessions:
 - Maymester Deadline: May 14, 2018
 - Sessions A, C and D Deadline: June 4, 2018
 - Julymester, Session B Deadline: July 10, 2018
 - Augmester Deadline: August 6, 2018
- CU Denver | Anschutz sessions:
 - Maymester deadline (CU Denver campus only): May 14, 2018
 - Summer semester deadline (CU Denver and Anschutz campuses): June 4, 2018
- CU Colorado Springs session:
 - June 11, 2018

Step 4: Apply for the College Opportunity Fund (COF)

- CU Boulder - August 22, 2018
- CU Denver | Anschutz - June 29, 2018
- CU Colorado Springs - July 30, 2018

Step 5: Pay fees and non-waived tuition

- CU Boulder - Listed on tuition bill
- CU Denver | Anschutz
 - Dependents: May 31, 2018
 - Employees: June 29, 2018
- CU Colorado Springs - June 18, 2018
