# **Budget Basics** [1]

- Describe the meaning of the budget on a fund-by-fund basis, in particular budget-based vs. cash-based funds;
- Explain how budgeting is different from, but relates to, the accounting function at the University of Colorado; and,
- Identify budgets on financial reports and know how they relate to available resources.
