From any page on the OUC website (www.cu.edu/controller ^[2]), you can click on "Tax" in the horizontal navigation at the top of the page -- then select the Tax-Exempt Information link to arrive at www.cu.edu/controller/tax/tax-exempt-information ^[3]. This is the go-to page for most department questions.
