You can inspire other employees to take a new look at their own procedures. You may even win a cash prize.

This year's submission period will close March 31, after which we'll begin the difficult process of selecting semifinalists and then, the winners. Winning projects -- to be announced before the end of the current fiscal year -- will be awarded cash prizes ranging from \$1,000-1,500 (all subject to taxes and withholding).
