CU: Animal Facility Access	Required for all CU Boulder Infrastructure and Sustainability employees.	This 30-minute course covers procedures and risk awareness training for facilities operations personnel. HCM Course Code: u10075 Start Course ^[3]
CU: CU Boulder Facilities Management Kubota Safety Training	Required for all CU Boulder Facilities Management Outdoor Services and Grounds staff members.	This 15-minute course covers how to inspect vehicles before and after use, how to operate Kubotas safely on campus, and how to load equipment properly while following workplace safety protocols. HCM Course Code: u10139 Start Course ^[4]
CU: Facilities Management Lockout/Tagout Safety Program (CU Boulder)	Required for any employee who operates or maintains equipment that requires lockout/tagout procedures to ensure the proper shutdown and isolation of energy sources prior to operation or maintenance.	This 30-minute course provides information specific to CU Boulder Facilities Management and its implementation of the OSHA Control of Hazardous Energy standard (Lockout/Tagout) contained in 29 CFR 1910.147. This standard outlines measures for controlling different types of hazardous energy. HCM Course Code: u10104 ? Start Course ^[5]

CU: Facilities Management - Battery Charging and Changing Safety Awareness	Recommended for all Facilities Management employees who charge and change large batteries that are capable of producing explosive hazards.	This 20-minute course will provide awareness of the hazards presented by charging and changing batteries and mitigation of occupational risks. HCM Course Code: u10105 Start Course [6]
CU: Facilities Management - Heavy Metals Safety Awareness	Recommended for all Facilities Management employees whose tasks involve metal work, machining, welding, and industrial housekeeping.	This 20-minute course will provide awareness of the hazards presented by heavy metals, their health effects, and mitigation of occupational risks. HCM Course Code: u101XX Start Course [7]
CU: Facilities Management - Hydrogen Sulfide Awareness	Recommended for all Facilities Management employees whose tasks involve hydrogen sulfide gas exposure and confined space entry.	This 20-minute course will provide awareness of the hazards presented by hydrogen sulfide, its health effects, and mitigation of occupational risks. HCM Course Code: u101XX ? Start Course [8]
CU: Facilities Management - Lockout Tagout Sign-In Sign Out Training	Required for all Facilities Management Lockout Tagout Principal Authorized and Authorized Users.	This 25-minute course provides instruction on expectations for conducting lockout tagout in Facilities Management. The course will cover requirements outlines in the Facilities Management Lockout Tagout Safety Program. HCM Course Code: u101XX ? Start Course [9]
CU: Facilities Management - Silica Awareness Training	Recommended for all Facilities Management employees whose tasks involve silica such as grinding, cutting, placing, and repairing drywall and concrete work.	This 20-minute course will provide awareness of the hazards presented by silica fibers, their health effects, and mitigation of occupational risks. HCM Course Code: u10106 Start Course [10]

CU: Emergency Response – Vehicle Spills	<p>This course is recommended for CU Boulder employees who operate, work around, or supervise vehicles, equipment, fueling operations, or facilities where spills may occur. It is strongly recommended for operations support staff, student employees, and applicable contractors. This course is required for bus or other CMV fleet vehicle operators, maintenance and fleet shop staff, supervisors, and any employee who is expected to use a spill kit. This course should be completed upon hire and before independent work, with refresher training provided annually or as procedures change</p>	<p>This 30-minute long course teaches CU Boulder employees how to safely recognize, contain, and report spills; use spill kits appropriately; and follow required EH&S and OCC notification procedures to protect people, property, and the environment.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10154 ?Skillsoft Library ID: _scorm12_cu_u10080_0001</p> <p>Start Skillsoft [11]</p>
