<b>CU: Facilities Radiation Safety Awareness</b>	Required for Facilities management employees at Anschutz.	This 30-minute course covers how to identify where radiation exists on campus; list the hazards of radiation; and distinguish between actions that align with workplace policy and actions that violate policy. <b>CU: Green Tagging and Equipment Disposals</b>	<p>This course is required for all Facilities Management staff who may encounter green-tagged equipment during the course of their work, including maintenance, operations, grounds, and event support personnel.</p>	<p>This 30-minute course provides an overview of the green tagging process used to prepare laboratory and clinical equipment for disposal, repair, or relocation. Learners will gain an understanding of what green tags represent, the roles of Environmental Health &amp; Safety (EHS), and how to interpret tag dispositions such as “Trash,” “Recycle,” “Refrigerant,” and “Surplus.”</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u00299</p> <p><a href="#">Start Course</a> [6]</p>
<b>CU: Working in Animal Housing</b>	<p>Required for all facilities personnel at the University of Colorado Denver or CU Anschutz who may enter the animal housing facilities (vivaria).</p>	<p>This 30-minute course covers personal protective equipment, disinfection processes, and traffic patterns inside the vivarium to prevent contamination or disruption of the animal colonies used in research.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u00144 CU-SIS Course Code: SK026</p> <p><a href="#">Start Course</a> [7]</p>
