CU: Confidentiality and Compliance	Required for all personnel at the Wardenburg Health Services (WHS) as part of initial compliance training.	<p>This 30-minute course provides an introduction to compliance at Health and Wellness Services including FERPA, HIPAA, State of Colorado laws, University of Colorado regulations, and internal policies.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10063</p> <p>Start Course ^[3]</p>
CU: Health and Wellness Data Confidentiality Acknowledgement	Required for all personnel at the Wardenburg Health Services.	<p>This course is lasts approximately 10-15 minutes and required for all CU Boulder Health and Wellness Services (HWS) employees. It aims to educate participants on the expectations and guidelines for maintaining the confidentiality of various HWS records and information, ensuring compliance with relevant federal and state laws, as well as university and HWS policies.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10133</p> <p>Start Course ^[4]</p>
CU: Health and Wellness Conflicts of Interest or Commitment Acknowledgement	Required for all personnel at the Wardenburg Health Services.	<p>This course takes approximately 10-15 minutes to complete and is required for all CU Boulder Health and Wellness Services (HWS) employees. It aims to educate participants on the expectations and processes for the disclosure of actual or potential conflicts of interest or commitment in accordance with applicable.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10014</p> <p>Start Course ^[5]</p>

CU: Mediat Legacy Overview	Required for anyone scheduling clinic appointments or managing health records in the Mediat system.	<p>This course takes approximately 60 minutes to complete and provides an overview of the Mediat system, which is used to manage appointments and electronic health records (EHRs) at the Wardenburg Health Center's Medical Clinic, CAPS at C4C, and the Williams Village Center.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10135</p> <p>Start Course ^[6]</p>
CU: Navigating Practice Management	This course is required once for all new hires at the Medical Clinic and should be completed within the first two weeks of your start date.	<p>This 40-minute course provides an overview of the Mediat system, which is used to manage electronic health records at the Wardenburg Health Center's Medical Clinic. You must take the quiz and score 80% or higher to receive credit for completing this course.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10119</p> <p>Start Course ^[7]</p>
CU: Point-of-Care Rapid A Strep Annual Competency	This course is required for all medical staff that perform strep testing at Medical Services at Wardenburg Health Center, CU Boulder.	<p>This 20-minute course describes the process of performing the OSOM Ultra Strep A Rapid Throat Screen and related quality control testing.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10130</p> <p>Start Course ^[8]</p>
CU: Point-of-Care Urine Pregnancy (hCG) Annual Competency Assessment	This course is required for all medical staff who perform urine point-of-care testing at Medical Services, Wardenburg Health Center, CU-Boulder.	<p>This 15-minute is required for all medical staff who perform urine point-of-care testing at Medical Services, Wardenburg Health Center, CU-Boulder. Upon completion of this course, learners should be able to perform pregnancy testing and related quality control testing.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10122</p> <p>Start Course ^[9]</p>

CU: Wardenberg Infection Control	Required for all employees.	<p>This 45-minute course is required for all Wardenberg staff members to identify the benefits of adhering to scientifically accepted principles and practices of infection control to our patients, our staff, and our families. In this course, you will learn about the different ways that pathogens can spread and what you can do to prevent this spread. The course includes a track for clinical staff as well as a track for non-clinical staff.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10114</p> <p>Start Course ^[10]</p>
CU: Skills for Mental Health Support	Recommended for CU Boulder staff.	<p>This 15-minute course introduces the Recognize, Respond, and Refer framework you can follow when a member of the CU Boulder community is experiencing mental health challenges. This course is a prerequisite for the in-person Recognize, Respond, Refer: Skills and Practice course.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10120</p> <p>Start Course ^[11]</p>
CU: Safety and Risk Management	Required annually for designated Wardenburg Health Services (WHS) employees.	<p>This 30-minute course covers staff and patient safety as well as the basics of managing risk. WHS employees must complete New Personnel Orientation as a prerequisite.</p> <p>HCM Course Code: u10062</p> <p>Start Course ^[12]</p>
