CU: Animal Program Refresher	Required for anyone listed on a research protocol that involves the use of animals.	This 30-minute course is a refresher to be taken annually after the initial Animal Program Orientation courses are completed. This course is for all personnel on research protocols involving animals. You must have completed the initial Animal Program Orientation courses once before taking this course as the annual refresher. CU: Disease Prevention and Control in the Animal Housing Facilities	Required for all employees conducting animal research at the University of Colorado Denver. This course is the second of three online courses to be completed before attending the in-person animal housing facilities training.	This 30-minute course covers the risks associated with using animals (especially rodents) in research, diseases, and how to control them within the facility. CU: Animal Program Orientation is a prerequisite for this course. HCM Course Code: u60006 CU-SIS Course Code: SK017 <u>Start Course</u> [5]

CU: Standard Operating Procedures	Required for all University of Colorado Denver Anschutz Medical Campus personnel who intend to access the animal housing facilities. This course is third in the OLAR Animal Program Orientation series.	This 30-minute course covers Standard Operating Procedures or practices that are required inside the animal housing facilities, including personal protective equipment, supplies, aseptic technique, and disinfection. CU: Animal Program Orientation and CU: Disease Prevention and Control in the Animal Housing Facilities are prerequisites for this course. HCM Course Code: u60005 CU-SIS Course Code: SK025 <u>Start Course</u> [6]
CU: Working in Animal Housing	Required for all University of Colorado Denver Anschutz Medical Campus Facilities staff who may enter the animal housing facilities (vivaria).	This course describes personal protective equipment, disinfection processes, and traffic patterns inside the vivarium to prevent contamination or disruption of the animal colonies used in research. HCM Course Code: u00144 CU-SIS Course Code: SK026 <u>Start Course</u> [7]
